## **DECISION AND ORDER**

The matter of PERB Case No. CA-330 having come regularly for hearing before the Phoenix Employment Relations Board at its open meeting on August 20, 2013, and the Board, having considered the Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendation dated June 14, 2013, along with the arguments of counsel and record to date, and, upon motion made and seconded on the first charge, and by a vote of 4-0, and upon motion made and seconded on the second charge, and by a vote of 3-1, in accordance with Phoenix City Code, § 2-211 and Rule 5.6 of the PERB Rules and Regulations, now, therefore.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED adopting the Findings and Conclusions of Law of the Hearing Officer, and that the Findings and Conclusions of Law of the Hearing Officer with respect to PERB Case No. CA-330 are herein incorporated by reference as part of this Decision; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of Phoenix, its officers and agents, cease and desist from interfering with employee rights under the Ordinance and from refusing to negotiate with PLEA on mandatory subjects of bargaining.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of Phoenix, its officers and agents engage in good faith negotiations with PLEA with regard to procedures for reimbursement of employees adversely financially affected by elimination of the Class D uniform for patrol officers in Unit IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of Phoenix conspicuously post a copy of this Order in every City employee work location where notices to employees are customarily posted, for a period of 30 calendar days.
