Record, material, or information requested: On Friday April 2, 2010 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm at approx. 7<sup>th</sup> St and Watkins Officer [REDACTED] stopped a vehicle for speeding (60 mph in a 40 mph zone). The driver had two different types of drivers license suspensions. The passenger was the owner of the vehicle. When advised the car was going to be impounded for 30 days (per statute - 28-3511) the passenger stated she was Councilman Mike Johnson's neice and requested that the car be released to her. When the officer refused, she requested to speak to a police supervisor. Sgt. [REDACTED] arrived at the scene and was told by the female owner of the car that she was pregnant, not feeling well, and that's why she allowed the suspended driver to drive her car. She stated that she was aware that the driver had some problems with his license about 1 year ago but believed everything was cleared up with his driving privileges. Sgt. [REDACTED] asked the female owner if she wished to see Fire due to her being pregnant and not feeling well. The female owner replied that she was not ill enough for that course of action. Sgt. [REDACTED] explained the car would NOT be released and explained the statute concerning impounding vechilces operated by a driver with suspended driving privileges. The female passenger then requested to speak to his police supervisor. Sgt. [REDACTED] contacted Lt. [REDACTED] on the phone and Lt. [REDACTED] gave instructions that the car NOT be impounded so as "not to throw gas on the fire of the current political situation."

I am requesting a copy of the digital video and audio recording taken by Officer [REDACTED] of this traffic stop and subsequent contact. A CD copy of this video was given to Sgt. [REDACTED] Officer [REDACTED]'s current motor supervisor.
